

## Canadian Corporation for Studies in Religion Seeks a Secretary

The <u>Canadian Corporation for Studies in Religion (CCSR)</u> is a consortium of nine learned societies and institutes, including the Association for Canadian Jewish Studies, the Canadian Association for the Study of Muslims and Islam, Canadian Society for the Study of Religion, the Canadian Society of Biblical Studies, the Canadian Society of Patristic Studies, the Canadian Theological Society, the Société québécoise pour l'étude de la religion, the Société canadienne de théologie, and the Association catholique des études bibliques au Canada.

The primary purpose of the CCSR is to support the publication of scholarly research in the field of Religious Studies. Since its inception in 1971, the Corporation has published the journal *Studies in Religion / Sciences Religieuses*. It also supports the publication of three book series: Matière à Pensée (*Les Presses de l'Université de Montréal*), Studies in Christianity and Judaism and Advancing Studies in Religion (*McGill-Queen's University Press*).

The Corporation is seeking a new secretary, to replace our current secretary, Dr. Jennifer Selby (Memorial University), for a three-year term, beginning in July 2023. Bilingualism (French/English) is ideal, as are strong organizational skills. Dr. Selby will offer mentorship in the transition. As with all other roles in the CCSR executive, this is a non-remunerated voluntary position.
