



## Canadian Corporation for Studies in Religion Seeks a Student Representative

The [Canadian Corporation for Studies in Religion \(CCSR\)](#) is a consortium of nine learned societies and institutes that include: the Association for Canadian Jewish Studies, the Canadian Association for the Study of Muslims and Islam, Canadian Society for the Study of Religion, the Canadian Society of Biblical Studies, the Canadian Society of Patristic Studies, the Canadian Theological Society, the Société québécoise pour l'étude de la religion, the Société canadienne de théologie, and the Association catholique des études bibliques au Canada.

The primary purpose of the CCSR is to support the publication of scholarly research in the field of Religious Studies. Since its inception in 1971, the Corporation has published the journal *Studies in Religion / Sciences Religieuses*. It also supports the publication of three book series: *Matière à Pensée (Les Presses de l'Université de Montréal)*, *Studies in Christianity and Judaism* and *Advancing Studies in Religion (McGill-Queen's University Press)*.

**The Corporation is seeking a new student representative** for a two-year term, renewable, beginning in July 2023. Bilingualism (French/English) is ideal. The representative will liaise with the students of member associations, ensure the information flow of CCSR and member society opportunities, initiate student-centred activities, bring student concerns to CCSR executive, and attend two CCSR meetings annually. The President will offer mentorship in the transition. As with all other roles in the CCSR executive, this is a non-remunerated voluntary position.
